Geography

Make a map of a garden (real or imaginary). Can you label the features?

Challenge: Can you create symbols for the features?

English

Make a seed packet for an imaginary plant. Draw a picture of what the plant will look like and write a description of it. Write some instructions on how to look after it. **Challenge:** use some exciting adjectives to describe your plant.

Art/I.C.T.

With a grown up research plants and flowers - be safe online. Create a flower or plant! You can choose your media - it could be paint, felt pens, collage etc.

P.E.

Use your garden or the local park to 'keep fit'. Record the activities you do.

Challenge: can you set up an activity trail for a member of your family to take part in?

Science/Maths

(End of Term 5 task). Continue to grow your sunflower at home. Record the growth.

Challenge: can you record how much your sunflower has grown over a week/2 weeks/a month etc.

Make a poster about someone who helps you at home. List all the ways in which they help you.

Challenge: how do you help someone else? List the things you do to help someone at home.
