

# 'Helping children make healthy choices'

Dear Parent / Guardian

Life Education Centres provide health and drug education for Primary Schools. We aim to help children develop the confidence and thinking skills needed to make informed health choices.

We bring a fully equipped mobile classroom to the school where children take part in an age appropriate session. All programmes link with and support the National Curriculum and are taught by trained educators. The children explore a range of health related issues such as hygiene and healthy eating, managing emotions and keeping safe. In the junior years children will explore of the use and effects of tobacco, alcohol and other substances.

The classroom is designed to give the children a very positive and memorable experience. The classroom features a number of electronic devices, such as a full size model of the human body, a fibre-optic star ceiling, an interactive talking brain and specially designed audio-visual materials. The children also meet Harold our happy, healthy singing giraffe.

Family Workbooks are now available as an ideal back-up material to enhance your child's understanding of the programmes taught in the Life Education Centre.
