Both posts are for 25 hours per week, term time only, and will be fixed term contracts in the first instance, with the possibility of further extension. One post is a maternity cover, fixed term until 31/08/19. (N.B. We would consider splitting one of the 25 hour posts into two positions of a combination of these hours to meet our needs).

Dependent on candidates experience and expertise, the successful applicants could work in our Early Years classes, Key Stage 1 classes or a combination of both, to complement our existing TA provision. Applicants are asked to specify all relevant skills, knowledge, experience and expertise regarding both Key Stages within their covering letter. We are looking for enthusiastic, committed and highly effective Teaching Assistants who are good-humoured and sensitive. They should have high expectations of children's learning and behaviour, love working with young children and be able to form excellent relationships with them. Applicants should be committed to improving pupil outcomes and have a proven track record of working with children with SEN, whether individually or in small groups, and be able to demonstrate excellent impact upon learning.
