Design Technology

We will be designing and making shields with card. We will investigate how to make a pulley/lever. We will be making Easter cards and baskets using card and paper.

Music

We will be focussing on the performance element of music through songs and instrument playing. Reggae will be our focussed genre of music this term. We will be learning a selection of Easter and Spring songs.

Mathematics

We will continue to develop our knowledge of the number system, counting, partitioning, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will use and apply our knowledge of maths to help us solve more complex problems.

We will continue to work on problems with shape and measures.

We will be adding amounts of money, giving change and learn how to manage money such as pocket money. We will be identifying fractions; a whole, ½ ½ ½ and thirds.

Art

We will be looking at the work of David Hockney and discussing how he uses colours to portray different seasons. We will paint our own castle pictures in this style.

We will also study perspective in pictures and create our own castle picture with perspective.

We will focus on our 'Fundamental Skills' which will

enable us to develop our co-ordination, fitness and

stamina through learning the skills needed to play

throwing, catching, sending and receiving games such

as mini-tennis.

In dance we will use castle music as a stimulus for

our own dances.

Computing

We will continue to practice and

improve our word processing and

drawing skills. We will be researching

the internet using ipods to find

information about castles.

We will use simple algorithms to

program digital devices.

Science

We will be looking at a variety of materials and their properties. We will discuss appropriate materials for building a castle. We will be looking at, and naming local wild flowers, fruits and trees. We will be finding out and describing how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Geography

We will be looking at castles in the local area and investigating why they were built in their location.

We will also be making a visit to a castle.

We will continue to develop our mapping skills by identifying local castles an a large map and through making our own maps and plans of castles.
