The whole school will take part in a range of activities and acts of collective worship.

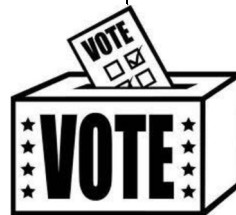


- To reflect upon and understand the meaning of Christmas within the Christian faith

As a School Council we discuss rights and responsibilities and also discuss this through our PSHE lessons.



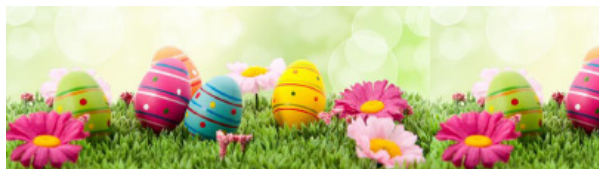
- For children to understand democratic processes, different points of view, fairness and responsibility
- For children to understand that we live in a democracy



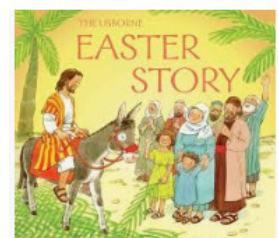
Easter
