Art / Technology / English

Design and make a pond creature - it can be real or imaginary! Challenge: Can you write a set of instructions explaining how you made your pond creature?

Science/Maths/PSHE

Make a healthy snack or drink and follow a recipe closely, measuring out the ingredients. Challenge: Can you record how many healthy snacks / drinks you have over a week? How will you display this information?

Geography / Science

Visit a local pond with your family eg, Jug's Hole, Cannop Ponds, Soudley Ponds. What can you see there? You could take some photos or draw a picture of the pond. Challenge: Can you make a map showing your journey to the pond? Can you label it?

Science/I.C.T./ English

With an adult, research your favourite pond animal.
