# Music and RE

In music this term, we will be learning to understand and practice reading different symbols to show pitch, to sing and draw pitch patterns, to read and understand the notation for the song 'Once a Man Fell in a Well', and to use a tuned percussion instrument to play a song, to complete the notation for a short song using a threeline stave.
