Parents' Evenings



A reminder that our mid-year parents' evenings will be held this week, on **Wednesday 28th February**, 3.15 - 5.30 p.m. and **Thursday 28th February** 3.15 - 7.00 p.m.

Parents may make appointments directly with Class Teachers, or alternatively ring the School Office to arrange an appointment time. Appointment times are limited to 10 minutes per child to ensure an opportunity for all parents to meet the Teachers.

This term's parents' evening is an opportunity to discuss your child's progress and to look at the work they have been doing this year. Parents are advised to arrive 5 minutes before their appointment time to allow time to look at their child's work beforehand.

Life Education Lessons

The Life Education Classroom will be on site on **Thursday 28th February and Friday 1st March.** For those parents who are new to the school this year, this is a mobile classroom in which the children are taught basic guidelines about good health and their bodies, and is the beginning of a graduated health education programme that is available for all year groups in all Gloucestershire schools to purchase. The lessons are interesting and fun and we have found them to be of great benefit in previous years. This year our lessons will be taking place in a new learning environment - the 'LifeSpace' inflatable classroom.

Should any parents wish to find out more, the Life Education teacher will be holding a parents' session on Friday 1st March 9.00-9.25 a.m. Any interested parents should register their interest at the School Office by Wednesday 27th February.
