English

<u>Phonics</u> - we shall revise Phase 5 sounds and alternative sounds. We will learn about using prefixes and suffixes ('s/es', 'un' 'ing / ed', 'er/est').

<u>Writing</u> - we will be learning about report writing. We will practice using conjunctions to join words and ideas in our sentences. We will also practise writing questions. We will learn how to use alliteration, similes, rhyme and onomatopoeia in our writing. <u>Reading</u> - we will focus on the non-fiction text 'Toys From The Past' by Sally Hewitt and will share a range of non-fiction texts in relation to the topic.

Design Technology

We will be discussing food groups and the importance of a balanced diet. We will also learn the importance of food hygiene. We will design and make a healthy snack for a picnic.
