English

We will be learning the story of Little Red Riding Hood and writing our own versions focussing on using a range of punctuation. For our non-fiction, we will write a non-chronological report about seasons and write a persuasive leaflet for an adventure park. We will look at using question marks and exclamation marks.

Maths

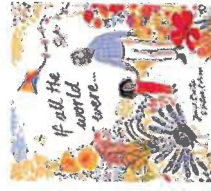
This term we will be learning to add and subtract numbers within 20 and bridging 10. We will learn the days of the week and months of the year. We will also be learning to tell the time to o'clock and half past the hour. We will sequence events in chronological order and compare time using the language of quicker, slower, earlier and later.

Science

In Science, we will be using everything that we have learnt about seasons, plants and animals to explore our local environment in the real world.

We will be making bird feeders, exploring habitats and observing changes across the seasons.

Music and RE

In music this term, we will be making movements to music using appropriate pulse and tempo. We will be choosing and playing instruments for our 'under the sea' theme. We will respond to changes in the music and create pitches and rhythms.

In RE, we will be learning about the Jewish community and how they live their lives. We will be finding out more about Shabbat and how it is celebrated in the Jewish home. We will retell stories linked to Hanukkah.



Phonics

This term, we will revisit the Phase 5 alternative sounds ready for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check.

We teach phonics every day and follow the scheme 'Little Wandle'. Children will read every day during phonics lessons and read the same book at least three times a week to develop fluency and comprehension. A home reading book will come home in your child's book bag and will be shared with an adult in school.

We will continue to bring a library book home each week. In Year 1 we will change our library books **every Friday**.

Art and DT

In Art, we will be learning about artists who are inspired by flora and fauna. We will explore and talk about their artwork and then use different materials to create our own pieces. We will use drawing and collage techniques.

In DT, we will be exploring the skill of sewing. We will learn different techniques for joining before designing and making a product.

History

In History this term, we will be building on our knowledge of old and new transport. We will explore the significant people who have had an impact on the development on the railway, Isambard Kingdom Brunel and George Stephenson.

We will link the learning to our local history and learn about the impact that the railways had in the Forest of Dean.

Computing

This term in computing, we will learn how to use a word processor and think about how it might be useful in the future. We will identify and find keys, before adding text to a page by pressing keys on the keyboard.

We will also revisit our Coalway Online Safety rules.

PSHE

Being my best

In PSHE, we will be learning about the different food groups and understanding the need for a balanced healthy diet. We will find out about good personal hygiene and the importance of washing our hands to prevent the spread of germs.

We will find out that learning a new skill requires practice and we will learn how to give positive feedback and praise.

PE

We will have two sessions of PE a week.

Session 1 is Target Games where we will develop our overarm and underarm throwing skills to send an object towards a target.

Session 2 is Gymnastics where we will be going to the Forest of Dean Gymnastics Centre for our sessions.

PE afternoon is a Monday – Classes 3 and 4

Gymnastics sessions are Thursday morning – Classes 3 and 4
