Adverse Weather Conditions

As winter approaches please can we remind you about our general procedures regarding possible school closure in the event of severe weather:

- 1. Closure of the school will be posted on the school website www.coalway-inf.gloucs.sch.uk
- 2. If there is heavy snowfall overnight you will be contacted by text to your mobile phone by 8.15 a.m. the next day informing you of closure of the school.
- 3. If you have not received a text message you may check by telephoning the school after 8.30 a.m. to check if the school is open.
- 4. Listen to Radio Gloucestershire FM 104.7 and/or Severn Sound FM 102.4; AM 774. They will give news about school closures.
- 5. Access the Gloucestershire website to view the list of schools that are closed www.glosclosedschools.com
- 6. It may be necessary for the school to close during the course of the day. In that case, it is very important that we have an emergency contact number as a text message will be sent in the first instance.
