

You can help your child by:

- Listening to your child read their reading book and practise their phonics.
- Counting, sorting and recognising numbers to 10 using their number cards. Beginning to use objects to count and find the totals of 2 groups.
- Continuing to encourage independence when getting dressed and undressed.
- Taking every opportunity to praise your child's achievements – however small they may be!
- Supporting your child's perseverance skills, encouraging them to have a go even when things are difficult.
