

Odd Socks Day



Classes 3 & 4 thought about our Coalway Bees and how we could **Be Kind** and **Supportive** to our friends.






Class 3 enjoyed filling up buckets for their friends with 'pick me up' messages and writing special messages on a friendship chain.



Class 4 designed their own pairs of odd socks on odd socks day!




Classes 5 & 6 made friendship cards, friendship posters, 'pick me up' thumbs and friendship bracelets for each other.

We were respectful and were silent for 1 minute






Operation Christmas Child






Children In Need
