## You can help your child by:

- Listening to your child read their reading book and practise their phonics.
- Counting, ordering and recognising numbers to 10 using their number cards. Use objects to add and find the totals of 2 groups.
- Playing board games to encourage turn-taking and recognition of 'dice dot patterns' without counting.
- Taking every opportunity to praise your child's achievements, however small they may be!
- Supporting your child's perseverance skills, encouraging them to have a go even when things are difficult.
