What an awesome show! We will miss Coalway Infants. Well done kids!!

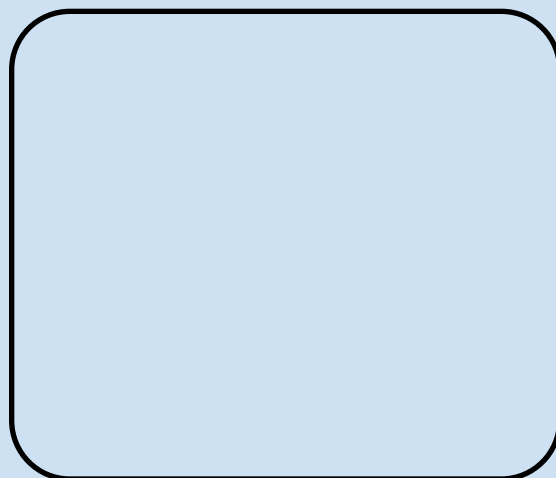
I thought the show was AMAZING!
