Challenge: You could look at forests in other parts of the UK or in other parts of the world. Talk about how they are the same or different.

## Art

Collect some natural materials from your local woods.

Make a collage of a woodland animal or create your own imaginative forest creature!

### PE / English


Can you create your own team game?
