'My teachers help me to learn. They help me to count on in tens. I love assembly because we sing'. Elsie

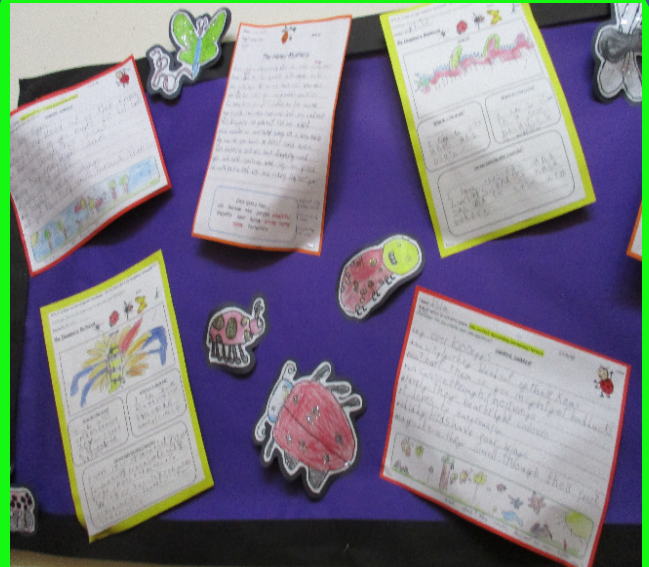
'I love the iPads, teachers and the work' Lacey
