Absence from Learning Request Form

As you are aware, from 1 September 2013 legislation prohibits any school from authorising leave of absence for holidays except in exceptional circumstances. Children are no longer entitled to any leave of absence for a holiday during term time. The school's attendance policy (available either on the school website or from the School Office) outlines in detail the Governing Body's policy, including guidelines regarding 'exceptional circumstances' for term time holidays. All absence requests are required to complete an Absence from Learning Request Form which can be collected from the School Office.

School Crossing Patrol

To ensure the children's safety, a School Crossing Patrol person is on duty from 8.30 a.m. - 9.10 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. - 3.35 p.m. daily - either Mrs. Moore or Mrs Edmonds.
