

## Let's get moving!! Reception classes Autumn Term 2 - 2021-22

This term Classes 1 and 2 will be learning through stories. Please choose at least 3 of the following home learning projects to complete before the end of term. As soon as any task is completed please send it in to school – all work will be treasured and displayed on a special homework board in the classroom. (Please let us know if you need anything to help your child complete a task). Remember – it's okay for the children to ask an adult to help them write or write for them if needed. The children can use the internet to help them as long as an adult knows they are doing so.

Make a pattern using natural materials you find in the garden or when you are out walking in the woods.

Ask the grown-ups to take a photograph of your pattern to bring or email to school.

Here is an example for you:



Ask a grown up to help you look in some non-fiction books. Can you find out some information about something you are interested in?

Write or draw what you have found out, or even ask a grown-up to write for you.



Use Purple Mash to make a Christmas card for your friend.  
Ask your grown-up to help you save the card in Purple Mash.



Make a set of paper Gruffalo characters and retell the story for your family.



Build a den in the garden for your teddy bear.  
Ask a grown-up to take a photograph to show us.



Use a paper plate or cut a circle out of card to make a bear or Gruffalo mask.
