Maths

We will be counting in 1's to 20 forwards and backward.

We will be reading, writing and ordering numbers to 20.

We will be finding 1 more and 1 less than given numbers to 20

We will be learning addition and subtraction facts to 10.

We will be exploring common 2D (flat) shapes and 3D (solid) shapes.

Art

We will be drawing / creating selfportraits using different media pencils, crayons, paint, pens and collage. We will explore Pop Art and the use of colour / pattern, studying the work of the famous artists Andy Warhol and Giuseppe Arcimboldo.

Music

We will identify the key elements of pitch and rhythm in a range of songs / music. We will be studying and learning Old School Hip Hop and Christmas songs.



English

Reading - we will be revising Phase 2 and Phase 3 phonemes and digraphs, focusing on blending words. We will read a range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry related to our topic. Our focus texts will be 'Super Duper You, 'Supertato' and 'Superworm'.

Writing - we will be working on letter formations, focusing on the ladder letters and one armed robot letters. We will continue to practise sentence sequencing and writing, focusing on storytelling and recounts.
