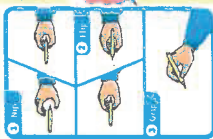


Physical Development: Dough disco

Simple Facts about Summer

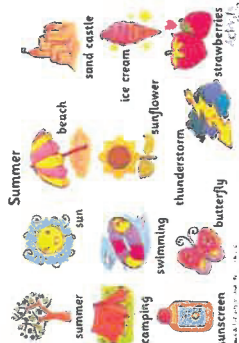
1. Summer comes after spring and it is the warmest time of the year.
