| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Use Phonics play https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/ to practice a reading game – <i>practice with the sounds you aren't sure of in your phoneme pack.</i> *Choose a comic to read * Make your own comic using the words from your phonics play game *Write a list of the types of shoes the elves could make. *Write a thank you letter to the elves from the shoemaker for helping them make all of the shoes. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *How many shoes do you need to measure different items in your house? e.g. the sofa, your bed, the living room floor etc. *Put your families' shoes in order from biggest/longest to smallest/shortest. Whose shoes are the biggest and whose are smallest? *Find different ways to measure how long your families feet are e.g. how many pieces of pasta/Lego etc. long. |

Why? It's OK not to have enjoyed it but you watched something new. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Design and make new shoes for the shoemaker to give to the elves to make. *Maybe you could ask a grown up to teach you a new skill – sewing/knitting/collage. *Build the shoemaker a new workshop using one of your construction kits. |
