Mario let us touch the oldest thing ever, it was part of a meteorite! Bella


I liked seeing the Space Station and watching the astronauts float! Calla



Classes 5 & 6


Firstly, The Smeds and Smoos wanted to find a new planet to live on and wanted us to design and test some sort of vehicle that would help them to explore it.

The children decided that air was a great way to push the buggies along. The children tested to see if this method would work.


















We were visited by a real Scientist! Professor Bubbleworks




Professor Bubbleworks visited us and shared lots of different experiments with each class.
